Wilson County churches are working together to help serve for 15 weeks this winter.

CH is gearing up and preparing for the 5th season of Compassionate Hands Ministry and will once again be providing housing for the homeless each night beginning in December. St. Frances Cabrini has been asked again this year to participate and provide a ***Sunday night meal each week over these 15 weeks.*** **Our meals will be cooked and then brought to SFC to serve the guests from our Parish hall.** We will prepare and serve dinners on Sunday nights at here at SFC in our Parish hall for 15 weeks starting on December 3, 2017 - March 11, 2018. Dinner needs to be ready at 5:30 to be served at 5:45. Host Church vans will arrive shortly prior to 6 PM. Last year we had enough people who volunteered, we were able to divide up into groups/teams and each group/team cooked once a month.

Just as Deacon Hector mentioned in one of his Homily's, *"In the meantime, keep in mind that a humble attitude comes from the heart. So place yourself as a servant of the community rather than as a leader and immerse yourself in the spirit of generosity and you will be exulted"*.
